

**Rail v Road Facts – January 2015**  
**Annual Rail Seasons + Car Parking + London Zones 1-6**  
**still 35% cheaper than road**

*Calculations based upon an assumption of two journeys being made per day (i.e. an outward and return journey) and with an allowance being made for holidays (20 days annual leave) = Assumed number of journeys 480.*

<b>Milton Keynes to London Euston</b>	<b>Cost</b>	<b>Total Daily Cost</b>
Annual Rail Season Ticket (Without London Zones 1-6)	£4,888	£20.36
Annual Rail Season Ticket (with London Zones 1-6)	£5,812	£24.21
Annual Rail Season Ticket (without London Zones 1-6 but with Annual Rail Car Park permit)	£6,088	£25.36
Annual Rail Season Ticket (with London Zones 1-6 and with Annual Rail Car Park permit)	£7,012	£29.21

**ROAD**

**Milton Keynes Station to London Euston**

106 miles per day (53 miles outward & 53 miles return) = 2 journeys

480 journeys: 53 x 480 = 25,440 miles

Based on HMRC mileage rates:

10,000 miles @ 0.45p mile = £4,500

15,440 miles @ 0.25p mile = £3,860

Congestion Charge (discounted) = £10.50 per day

**Annual Cost** = £10,880

**Daily Cost up to 10,000 miles** = £58.22

**Daily Cost after 10,000 miles up to 25,440 miles** = £37.01

**Average Daily Cost** = £45.33

(Road calculations do not take into account capital cost of purchasing a vehicle or its financial depreciation. If these figures included then the costs shown would significantly rise further.)
